Conditions of Entry: Please ensure you are willing to comply with the following Conditions of Entry before you enter this NADEC competition. Your Signature is required on this entry form (where provided for) to acknowledge that you have read these rules and will abide by them.

- This NADEC event is to be conducted under EFA Rules
- Welfare of the Horse - FEI Code of Conduct - **Observed mistreatment or abuse of a horse will not be tolerated.** NADEC will take appropriate action as deemed necessary against those competitors that choose to disregard the rules pertaining to the welfare of the horse and the FEI code of conduct.
- All riders must wear an ASA approved helmet (AS/NZS 3838:1998 Current Australian Standard) at all times while mounted on a horse. NO helmet = NO ride
- Non-NADEC members & Non-EFA members - Must complete the Unregistered Rider Waiver (URW) This form must be forwarded together with the Associate entry forms and an **additional \$20 is payable with the entry fees.**
(NB: A Non-Member is a person who wishes to participate in this competition but is not a direct member of the EFA or NADEC. Upon completion of this Associate entry form and also completion of the URW and payment of the additional \$20 insurance the rider will be deemed to be a NADEC member during the competition for the purposes of participation only).
- Maximum number of classes per horse is 3 per day, over two consecutive levels at or above the horse's EFA graded level.
Horses competing below their graded level must compete HC.
- NADEC reserves the right to return incomplete and/or incorrect entries or entries with incorrect payment. CHECK YOUR ENTRIES
- NADEC reserves the right to alter or cancel any section of this event/competition program or to cancel this event/competition
- No refunds after close of entries without provision of a Vet or Medical certificate which must be supplied within 5 working days from the competition date.
- Should this event/competition be cancelled entry money will be refunded after a deduction has been made for administration fees.
- Riders under the age of 16 must have a parent or guardian present on the grounds at all times on the day of the competition.
- No electric or rope yards are permitted at any NADEC competition.
- STRICTLY NO DOGS ALLOWED.** Any person that flaunts this ruling will be ordered off the grounds.
- NADEC will not accept late or faxed entries. Neither NADEC, nor any of its' Committee Members will accept any responsibility whatsoever for delays which may be incurred by Australia Post resulting in entries not meeting the *close of entry* deadline nor for any entries that may be lost by Australia Post. It is the sole responsibility of the competitor to ensure that entries are forwarded so as to be received by NADEC in ample time to meet the *close of entry* date as set by NADEC for each competition. Important Notice - Competitors are required to travel to and from the competition with a waybill. A copy of this waybill must be handed in at the Secretary's Office (tin shed) on arrival in order to be permitted to compete. Competitors will be barred from competing if their name has not been marked off the DPI check list and will be requested to leave the grounds and entry fees will be forfeited. Competitors who forget to bring a copy of the waybill are advised they are not permitted entry to the grounds, fees will be forfeited. Dogs are prohibited, so please leave them at home: Competitors/Spectators will not be allowed entry if they bring dogs and competitors will forfeit their entry fees.

Be aware that the DPI may be present and will carry out random checks !!!
