A COPY OF THIS WAYBILL MUST BE PLACED IN THE BOX LOCATED IN THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE ON ARRIVAL IN ORDER TO BE PERMITTED TO COMPETE. COMPETITORS WILL BE BARRED FROM COMPETING IF THEIR NAME HAS NOT BEEN MARKED OFF THE DPI CHECK LIST AND WILL BE REQUESTED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS AND ENTRY FEES WILL BE FORFEITED. COMPETITORS WHO FORGET TO BRING A COPY OF THEIR WAYBILL ARE ADVISED THAT THEY WILL NOT HAVE PERMISSION TO ENTER THE GROUNDS, FEES WILL BE FORFEITED. DOGS ARE PROHIBITED, SO PLEASE LEAVE THEM AT HOME; COMPETITORS/SPECTATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ENTRY IF THEY BRING DOGS & COMPETITORS WILL FORFEIT THEIR ENTRY FEES.

BE AWARE THAT THE DPI MAY BE PRESENT AND WILL CARRY OUT RANDOM CHECKS.

Classes will not be split and are limited to 35 riders per class. NADEC members will receive 1st priority, thereafter it will be drawn on a 'first in, first served' basis. Entry fees will be returned to those riders that do not obtain a ride time on the draw.
